This Indenture made this thirteenth day of November in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and twenty one between William & Everette of the County of Southampton and Maria Everette his wife of the first part and James D. Maupin of the same County of the second part Witnesseth that whereas the said William & Everette stands jointly indebted to Harvey Williams of the City and State of New York as assignee of Duncan Henderson the Merchants of the Town of Petersburg in the sum of fourteen hundred and eighty one dollars and five cents by note payable 20th of March 1823 and in the further sum of fifteen hundred and sixty dollars and thirty cents by note payable 20th March 1823 in the year 1822 and whereas this slave Henry Simon and son are by and in Trust
