This Indenture made and entered into this 20th day of February of the year 1821
between David Morrison of the first part Thomas Redley and Benjamin Blunt of the
second part and Abraham Smith of the third part Whereas the said Smith of the third
part has heretofore agreed to and has this day transferred to the said Abraham of the first
part his interest in a certain execution from the Superior Court of Southampton
which issues in a writ Writ of Sheriff and commitment of Henry Smith and for the
benefit of the said A. P. Smith against Richard Harrison the which execution
amounts with interest and Cost up to this date to the sum of One thousand one
hundred and thirty dollars and twenty three and is which the said Morrison is bound
by agreement to repay with the interest accruing on that aggregate amount
to the said Smith on or before the 25th day of December next and whereas
the said Morrison is desirous of securing to the said Smith the prompt restitution
of the said sum up and to provide a fund from whence it may at any time
be made in the event of his death or failure to repay it by the time before
specified Now this Indenture therefore maketh that the said David Morrison
of the first part for and in consideration of the premises and the additional
consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Redley & Blunt
previous to the execution of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby admitted)
Has bargained and sold and by these presents does bargain and sell to the said Red
Redley and Benjamin Blunt a certain tract or parcel of Land situate in the county of
Southampton Benjamin being the same tract lately purchased by the said Morrison
of Richard Harrison &c containing two hundred and forty two and a half acres be
the same more or less and adjoining the land thereto held by the said Morrison
the Lands of the said Richard Harrison and others together with all and singular the
tenements hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging in any way now appurte
aining with the same and remainders reversion and reversions parts and
profits thereof to have and to hold the said tract of land with the appurtenances
thereunto and every part and parcel thereof to the said Thomas Redley and
Benjamin Blunt their heirs and assigns forever and the said David Morrison
for himself his heirs executors and assigns doth covenant with the said
Redley and Blunt their heirs and assigns that he will the said tract of
Land and premises unto the said Redley and Blunt their heirs assigns
free from the claims or demand of him the said Morrison and of all &c
