Indenture to
Bryant

This Indenture made and entered into this twentieth day of January one thousand eight hundred and twenty two between William Jenkins of Southampton County of the first part William D Goodwyn of the second part and James Jenkins and William D Goodwyn of the third part Witnesseth That whereas the said William D Goodwyn and George Goodwyn hath bound themselves securities for the said William Jenkins Guaranties to the payment of William Dalls debt in the sum of three thousand dollars in the county west of Surfer and in consideration of the further sum of one dollar in hand paid by the said James Bryant the receipt on hereof is hereby acknowledged Now to secure and indemnify the said William D Goodwyn and George Goodwyn from the payment of the said sum of three thousand dollars or any part thereof the said William Jenkins hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said James Bryant his heirs executors and administrators all that tract or parcel of Land on which the said William Jenkins now lives lying and being in the county of Southampton and bounded by the lands of Francis Peeling William D Moore and Alexander Pisto contains viz by a late survey two hundred and seven acres to have and to hold all the said tract or parcel of Land with all its appurtenances unto the said James Bryant his heirs and assigns forever as Trust And the said William Jenkins as the further Covenant and agree to and with the said William D Goodwyn That if he the said William D Goodwyn and George Goodwyn or either of them shall at any time become defunct in consequence of the above mentioned security ship that then the said James Bryant shall have full power to enter upon and make sale of the above noted tract of Land for ready money after one day previous notice and convey the same to the purchaser without any hindrance or molestation from him
