This Indenture made the 17th day of December A.D. one thousand eight hundred
and twenty one between Culver Edwards of the county of Southampton
one of the aforesaid County Virginian of the first part and Wells
Hardy Croft of the
County of Hampshire Virginia of the third part as follows the said Culver
Edwards is party in debt to the said Hardy Croft in the sum of One hundred
dollars to be paid on or before the 17th day of December next ensuing with
interest thereon till paid from that time as from of this date which the said Culver
Edwards is willing and desirous to bind him by this Indenture witnesseth that for
and in consideration of the premises and also for and the further consideration of one
dollar to the said Culver Edwards in hand paid by the said Wells Murphy above
before the executing and delivery of these presents by the said Culver Edwards hath
granted bargained and sold and by these presents with grant bargain and sell
unto the said Wells Murphy his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel
of Land lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and bounded as
follows adjoining the lands of Lazarus Cobb Patrick Dots and Nathaniel Pope
containing one hundred and twenty five acres more or less the remainder remaining
so and remanentes yearly after other rents issues and profits thereof and
any part and further thereof to have and to let the said tract or
place of Land with the premises and appurtenances before mentioned
unto the said Wells Murphy his heirs and assigns forever Upon trust nevertheless
that the said Wells Murphy shall as soon as he conveniently can after the 17th
day of December next ensuing and having advertised the time and place of sale
of the land and premises aforesay three several advertisements, one of which
shall be posted at the door of the court house of said County at least one
month previous to the day of sale he shall then proceed to sell the same
to the highest bidder for cash and out of the monies arising therefrom
first pay all reasonable charges attending the sale and then the debt of one
and the residue of the money (if any) shall pay to have the said Culver
Edwards his heirs or assigns or as before demand in return whereof the
said Culver Edwards is to make to Harry Croft one hundred at this house
