This Indenture made and executed this 20th day of December in the year of
about eighteen hundred and twenty one between George H Gray of the County
of Somerset the first part Mary Briggs of the County of Somerset the second
part and Benjamin Devaney of the said County of the third part
Witnesseth that whereas the said George H Gray who is justly indebted
unto the said Mary Briggs in the full sum of three hundred dollars
(as per Bond executed by the said Gray bearing the same date with these
present) and the said George H Gray having willing and desirous more
effectually to secure to the said Mary Briggs the sum aforesaid hath
agreed to convey unto the said Benjamin Devaney in trust to secure the
payment of the sum aforesaid Now this Indenture further witnesseth
for and in consideration of the premises aforesaid as well for and
in consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid
by the said Benjamin Devaney the receipt whereof the said George
H Gray doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained & conveyed
unto the said Benjamin Devaney a certain female negro slave named
Sunny to have and to hold unto the said Benjamin Devaney the
said female slave Sunny and her future increase to him and his
assigns forever In Trust nevertheless that unless the said George H
Gray shall fail refuse neglect or delay the payment of the sum of
three hundred dollars the sum aforesaid first mentioned that then
and in that case it shall be lawful for the said Benjamin Devaney
at the request of the said Mary Briggs or her heirs or assigns or the
said George H Gray his heirs and assigns to sell at public sale
