assigns covenants and agrees to and with the said Samuel Drake his
heirs executors administrators and assigns that she the said Mary M. Drake
for herself her heirs executors administrators and assigns will forever warrant
and defend the title of said Land against themselves their heirs executors
administrators and assigns and against all and every person or persons whomsoever
