This Indenture made this twentieth day of November in the year of our
 Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty one by and between Jacob Darron
 acting as trustee for Benjamin W Johnston late of the county of Southampton
 and State of Virginia and Richard Darron of the said County of the one part
 and Richard Darron of the other part Witnesseth that whereas the above
 named Benjamin W Johnston died by a certain deed in trust bearing date
 the 27th day of March one thousand eight hundred and eighteen convey to the
 said Jacob Darron in trust (to secure certain debts due and owing from the
 said Benjamin W Johnston to the said Richard Darron as set forth in
 the trust deed aforesaid) certain property in Lands as mentioned and
 described in the said Deed of Trust that is to say all that tract or parcel
 of Land situated lying and being in the County of Southampton on the
 North Side of Roanoke River containing by a late survey made by
 James Jones one hundred and fifty acres be the same more or less
 being the same Land which the said Benjamin W Johnston had purchased
 from the said Richard Darron as also all that Lot of Land contain-
 ing six acres be the same more or less situated on the South Side of the said
 river at Brown Ferry with all and singular the improvements and advantages
 of every kind including the ferry Landing fishing place &c - and whereas the
 said Benjamin W Johnston hath paid off and discharged the first debt
 mentioned in the said Deed in Trust to wit that of two thousand dollars
 in doing what he hath left consent of the said Richard Darron both and conveyed
 by Deed (the Ferry) commonly called Brown Ferry and whereas he the said
 Benjamin W Johnston to the said debt so neglected or delayed payment
 of the other two debts in the said trust Deed mentioned as the remainder
 of the property for that purpose conveyed indispensable and whereas the said
 Jacob Darron having given ~~there~~ as mentioned in the trust deed did
 on the day of the date of these presents set up the property aforesaid (except
 the Ferry) to the highest bidder for ready money and whereas the said
 Richard Darron became the purchaser of the same of one thousand three
 hundred and ninety dollars and hath duly accounted to him the said Jacob
