

Indenture made this thirty first day of December one thousand eight hundred and twenty one between Nicholas L Williams and Elizabeth his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part and Edwards Butts of the same County of the other part witnessed that the said Nicholas L Williams and Elizabeth his wife in consideration of the sum of one thousand dollars have given granted bargained and sold and by these presents do give grant bargain and sell unto the said Edwards Butts and his heirs forever all that tract or parcel of Land in the County of Southampton of which the said Nicholas L Williams purchased of Henry Belcher containing one hundred acres be the same more or less reference to the said Deed the boundaries whereof fully appear also one other tract or parcel of Land which the said Nicholas L Williams purchased of certain commissioners appointed by the County Court of Southampton to make sale of eighty two acres of Land belonging to the estate of Samuel Belcher deceased which said deed is also duly proved and recorded in the County Court of Southampton aforesaid and adjoining the Lands of Benjamin Cobb Mo. Charles Ellis John Williams Thomas E. Holaday and James Ellis to have and to hold the aforesaid tracts of Land together with their appurtenances to him the said Edwards Butts and his heirs forever And the said Nicholas L Williams and Elizabeth his wife then and each of their heirs executors administrators the aforesaid tract of Land with their appurtenances to him the said Edwards Butts his heirs and assigns forever shall and well forever warrant and defend Lawfully whosoever the said Nicholas L Williams and Elizabeth his wife have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day and year first above written Signed Sealed & delivered in presence of
