This Indenture made this 15th day of November September in the year of our Lord 1821 Between Benjamin Cobb and John Williams Commissioners appointed by a decree of the County Court of Southampton to make sale of eighty two acres of Land belonging to the estate of James Ellis deceased of the one part and Nicholas I Williams of the other part all of the County of Southampton - Witnesseth that the said Benjamin Cobb and John Williams for and in consideration of the premises aforesaid And also in consideration of the sum of One hundred and fourteen dollars and 80 cents Lawfull money of Virginia to them in hand paid or otherwise secured to be paid have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Nicholas I Williams and his heirs all the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land in the County of Southampton aforesaid containing eight two acres more or less as aforesaid and adjoining the lands of Thomas & William Michael Ellis John Williams James Ellis and Benjamin Cobb To have and to hold the said tract of Land together with the appurtenances to him the said Nicholas I Williams and his heirs And the said Benjamin Cobb and John Williams Commissioners as aforesaid and acting under the decree as aforesaid the said tract or parcel of Land with the appurtenances to him the said Nicholas I Williams his heirs and assigns forever In witness whereof the said Benjamin Cobb and John Williams have hereunto set their hands and affixed the seals the day and year above written signed and sealed in presence of
