This Indenture made the 27th day of December 1821 Between Claiborne Scott of the County of Southampton of the one part and Samuel Calvert of the said County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Claiborne Scott hath this day for and pursuant to the Statute of the said of three hundred dollars to him in hand made and truly paid by the said Samuel Calvert before the enclosing and delivery of these presents the aforesaid Scott bargain and sale unto the said Samuel Calvert his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid Containing one hundred and fifteen acres more or less of which the tract of Land on which the said Claiborne Scott now resides and bounded by the lands of George Cary orphan of Miles Cary and Thomas Ridley and others to have and to hold the said Land and tenements with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Samuel Calvert his heirs and assigns forever and the said Claiborne Scott for himself his heirs and executors assigns the right and title to the said tract of Land unto the said Samuel Calvert his heirs and assigns against the claims of himself or against the claims or claims of any other person or persons whatsoever shall and come lawfully warrant and defend by these presents In witness whereof the said Claiborne Scott hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day and year above written signed sealed acknowledged Claiborne Scott
