

Goodwyn

Cobb trustee

This Indenture made this 10<sup>th</sup> day of January in the year of our Lord 1822  
 Between Charles W Goodwyn of the one part Robert Goodwyn of the second  
 part and Benjamin Cobb of the third part all of the County of Southampton  
 Metropolis that whereas The said Charles W Goodwyn stands justly  
 indebted to the said Robert Goodwyn by certain writings obligatory  
 under his hands and seals to wit One Bond payable on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of  
 December 1822 for the sum of two thousand dollars one other payable  
 on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of December 1823 for the sum of two thousand dollar  
 and one other due payable on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of December 1824 for the  
 sum of two thousand dollars and whereas the said Charles W Goodwyn  
 is willing and desirous to secure and indemnify the said Robert Goodwyn  
 it is agreed by the said Charles W Goodwyn and Robert Goodwyn that  
 a conveyance in trust shall be made to the said Benjamin Cobb  
 in case the said Bonds or writings obligatory as aforesaid should not be  
 punctually paid when due Now this Indenture therefore Witnesseth  
 that the said Charles W Goodwyn for and in consideration of the promise  
 aforesaid and for the further consideration of the sum of One dollar  
 to him in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath  
 granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain  
 and sell unto make over and confirm unto the said Benjamin Cobb  
 and his heirs and assigns a certain trust plantation tract or parcel  
 of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid com-  
 only known and designated by the name of the Crof Keys including the  
 several tracts of Land attached thereto which the said Robert Goodwyn  
 purchased of Benjamin Cobb and which is of record in the County  
 Court of Southampton reference being had thereto the boundaries more  
 more fully appear and containing by estimation between six and  
 seven hundred acres be the same more or less and which said  
 plantation tracts and parcel of Land the said Charles W Goodwyn  
 bought of the said Robert Goodwyn which is also of record in the  
 County Court as aforesaid and all the estate right title & interest of  
 him the said Charles W Goodwyn of in and to the said land and  
 plantations as aforesaid To have and to hold the said plantation tracts  
 and parcels of Land and premises as aforesaid unto him or assigns  
 the said Benjamin Cobb his heirs and assigns in Trust executed by  
 and upon this express condition that if the said Charles W Goodwyn  
 his heirs or assigns shall punctually pay or cause to be paid
