acknowledged granted bargain and sold and by these presents doth
grant bargain and sell unto the said James P Holt his heirs and
assigns forever all the right title and interest in and to a certain
tract of Land lying and being in the county containing by
estimation one hundred and acres it being the tract or parcel
of Land conveyed by Charlesborne Deeds by and to the said Samuel Calvert
and which said record in the clerks office of Southampton county
count to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land to the
only proper use and behoof of him the said James P Holt his
heirs and assigns forever But the said Samuel Calvert does not
warrant and defend the right and title of the said tract of
Land except against the claim of himself or against the claim
of any persons claiming under him or his wife whereof the said
