This Indenture made this 19th day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand
 eight hundred and twenty one Between Natham Moorme of the County of Southampton
 and State of Virginia of the one part and Sarah Moorme of the same County
 and State of the other part Witnesseth that I the said Natham Moorme
 for and in consideration of the sum of eight hundred dollars to me in hand paid by the
 said Sarah Moorme the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged I the said
 Natham Moorme have granted bargained and sold and by these presents
 do grant bargain and sell unto the said Sarah Moorme to her and her
 heirs forever one certain tract or parcel of Land situate lying and
 being in the County aforesaid on the south side of Stokeway river
 containing eighty two acres more or less (Boundaries) as follows beginning
 ing at a Post oak a corner of tract of Susan Selks in parts line thence
 along the said Fork line to a burnt stump a corner of said Fork and
 Fosters line thence along Fosters line to a pine in the edge of Fork road
 thence up the said Fork road to a white oak a corner of Saquidins Selks
 line thence along Saquidins Selks line to a poplar a corner of Robert Selks
 line thence along the said Robert Selks line ^{to another corner of said Selks} thence along the said Selks line
 to a small Elm a corner of Susan Selks line ^{thence along said Fork & then} to the beginning to have and
 to hold the same part or parcel of Land with all the appurtenances
 therunto belonging unto the said Sarah Moorme to be held by her and her
 heirs and assigns forever and I the said Natham Moorme for myself
 and my heirs and all and every person and persons whosoever claiming
 under them shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents
 the same wherewith I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the
 day and year date before written signed sealed and delivered in presence
