these presents hath granted bargained sold aliened released
over and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain
alien release set over and confirm unto the said William J Everette
his heirs and assigns forever the aforesaid tract of one mile
seat and five hundred acres of Land thence adjoining
to hold the aforesaid one mile seat and five hundred acres of
Land to the said William J Everette his heirs and assigns
