the thousand eight hundred and twenty one Between Nicholas Bryant Mary
Bryant his wife and Silas Parvett of the County of Southampton and State of
Virginia of the one part and Lewis Morrill of the same County and State of
the other part Witnesseth that The said Nicholas Bryant Mary Bryant
his wife and Silas Parvett for and in consideration of the sum of five
hundred dollars to them in hand paid by the said Lewis Morrill
before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is
hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold and by these presents
do grant bargain and sell unto the said Lewis Morrill his heirs and
assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of Land whereon the said
Nicholas Bryant Mary Morrill resides lying and being in the aforesaid County of Peter
and Parish of Saint Lukes containing more or less acres in the same
more or less and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a black
oak standing near the run of the Spring branch a corner of Silas Parvett
in Drury Bryants line thence along the said Silas Parvett line South
seventy degrees west Ninety seven and a half poles to a small white
oak standing near the run of the Spring branch a corner in Silas Parvett
line thence down the run of the said Spring branch 58 met 20 poles 325 met
poles thence 113 met 14 poles thence 37 east 25 poles thence 57 612 poles thence
41 616 poles thence 330 610 poles thence 356 620 poles 345 616 poles then a
345 617 1/2 poles to a black gum corner of Lewis Morrill in Cooks line
