

Know all men by these presents that I John Wapier of the County of Southampton have sold unto Henry Lenoir of the same County a negro boy named George for the sum of one hundred and twenty seven dollars and sixty cents for which right and title of the above mentioned negro boy George I given under my hand this second of January Eighteen hundred and twenty one the above obligation is such whereas the above bound John Wapier stands indebted to Henry Lenoir both of the County above stated and State of Virginia the sum of one hundred and twenty seven dollars and sixty two cents with interest from date and pay the supposed amount on or before the 25th of October next being the only sole intention of securing a debt of the sum of one hundred and twenty seven dollars and sixty two cents as above stated then the obligation is void or else remain in full force and virtue given under my hand and seal the day and date above

This Indenture made this 16th day of January in the year one thousand eight hundred and twenty two by and between Seph Parker of Southampton County Virginia of the one part and John Martin of the same County and State of the other part witnesseth that for divers good causes and considerations of one dollar but more especially for and in consideration of one dollar to him the said Seph Parker in hand paid by the said John Martin at an instant the enacting and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged he the said Seph Parker for himself his heirs executors and administrators hath granted bargained sold demised and confirmed and by these these presents doth grant bargain sell demise and confirm unto the said John Martin a certain lot or parcel of Land lying in the County of Southampton aforesaid in the lower district of Stokely Parish and on the east side of the cypress swamp bounded as follows to wit Beginning in the road issuing from south Quay to Monroe at the place where the late according line between the said Seph Parker and Robinson Delmar and crosses the said road near and on the east side of the cypress swamp thence
