and State of Virginia a free man of colour for ever good cause and
considerations through moving have Emancipated manumitted and set
free from servitude and slavery and by these presents do Emancipate

Dunah a black woman about twenty one years of age whom I purchased
of Isaac Costery and I hereby misceus acquit and forever discharge the
said Dunah from all personal services to me or my heirs in witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand name and affixed my seal this
9th day of February 1822

hundred and twenty two between Nathaniel Bount and Sarah Eliza his wife of the
Borough of Norfolk and State aforesaid of the first part the President and
Directors and Company of the Farmers South of Virginia of the second part
and the said Alexander Sordau who was mutually chosen by the other parties
a trustee for the purpose therein mentioned of the third part Whereas the said
Nathaniel Bount and Sarah Eliza his wife for certain considerations and purposes
and upon certain conditions therein mentioned and declared did convey to the said
Alexander Sordau his heirs and assigns a certain piece parcel or tract of Land
situate lying and being in the County of Southampton on the South side of Station
river or Rockchorn road being the same piece or tract of Land that was conveyed
by James Alister and Elizabeth his wife to the said Nathaniel Bount by deed
bearing date the first day of November One thousand eight hundred and fifteen
all which more fully appear by reference to the said deed in the Court of the
County aforesaid also a lot piece or parcel of Land situate lying and being in the
Borough of Norfolk and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a stake or
stone on the East side of Potomack shore and on the South side of Leslie and
Christopher street Drumscook line thence running on said line North eighty seven
degrees east one hundred and thirty three feet to a stake and thence
South Eighty seven degrees west one hundred feet to a stake and thence North
