This Indenture made this 21st day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty two between John Thorpe and Elizabeth his wife of the county of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part the President Directors and Company of the Farmers Plant of Virginia of the second part and Alexander Sordani of the County of Norfolk who has been mutually shown by the aforementioned parties in writing for the purposes herein after mentioned of the third part Whereas the said John Thorpe is indebted to the said President Directors and Company in the just and full sum of four hundred and eighty dollars and sixty cents or two Notes or Bonds dated on the day of the date of the first note the one for the sum of two hundred and forty three dollars and thirty three cents payable twelve months after date and the other for two hundred and forty three dollars and thirty three cents payable ^{eighteen} months after date and the said Alexander Sordani has been mutually shown by the said John Thorpe and Elizabeth his wife for the purposes herein after mentioned of the third part Whereas the said Alexander Sordani is indebted to the said President Directors and Company in the sum of five Dollars to them in hand paid by the said Alexander Sordani at an before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt thereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargain sold allien incorporee release and confirm with him the said Alexander Sordani his heirs and assigns forever a certain piece parcel or tract of land lying and being in the county of Southampton on the south side of Nettoway river on Duckhorn road being the same piece parcel of Land that was conveyed by James Meillar and Martha his wife to Nathaniel Wough by deed bearing date the first day of November one thousand Eight hundred and Eighty seven and by the said Wough and Sarah Eliza his wife to the said Alexander Sordani by deed in Trust dated the first day of July one thousand Eight hundred and nineteen and lastly by the said Alexander Sordani in pursuance of the provisions of the said deed in Trust to the said John Thorpe by deed bearing date the 21st day of January one thousand Eight hundred and Twenty two as more fully appears by reference to the said deed on record in the court of the county of Southampton and all the appurtenances to the same belonging or in any wise appertaining To have and to hold the said piece or parcels of Land and its appurtenances unto him the said Alexander Sordani his heirs and assigns forever Upon Trust Overthelap and three presents and upon the express condition that if the said John Thorpe his heirs executors or administrators shall owe and truly pay or cause to be paid to the said President Directors and Company the amount of the two Notes as they may respectively fall due at the office of the President and Company in Norfolk with interest thereon from the dates thereof until paid then the presents and every thing herein contained herein shall cease absolutely and
