This Indenture made this twelfth day of January in the year from Lord or
 thousand eight hundred and thirty one Between Thomas Appelwhite of the county of
 Southampton of the one part and Amelun Rose of the aforesaid county of the
 other part witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred
 dollars to the said Thomas Appelwhite in hand paid by the aforesaid Amelun
 Rose the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged & the said Thomas
 Appelwhite hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth
 grant bargains and sell unto the said Amelun Rose and to his heirs and assigns
 forever one certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the county
 of Southampton and bounded by the Lands of John Gulgans and Amelun
 Rose containing by estimation one hundred acres and one quarter acre with
 the same river exp to have and to hold the above granted premises unto the aforesaid
 Amelun Rose and his heirs and assigns to the only proper
 use and behoef of him the said Amelun Rose his heirs and assigns
 and the said Thomas Appelwhite for himself his heirs to hold and
 grant and agree to and with the said Amelun Rose and his
 heirs that he will warrant and forever defend to the right and title
 to the above granted premises unto the said Amelun Rose and his
 heirs and assigns against the claims or demands of him the said Thomas
 Appelwhite and his heirs and against the claims or demands of all and
 every other person or persons whatsoever freely by these presents to witness
 whereof & the said Thomas Appelwhite has hereunto set my hand and seal
