the following slaves to-wit Dick Sack Maria Nelly and two children
Sam Pleasant and her two children Cambridge and Lucy to have
and to hold unto the said William L. Everett his heirs and assigns
forever the aforesaid Negro Slaves named as aforesaid and the said
Clements Rochelle for whose benefit the aforesaid slaves is conveyed
in trust to the said James Rochelle doth by these presents warrant
and defend the title to the aforesaid Slaves against him the said
Clements Rochelle or the said James Rochelle or any other person or
persons claiming by through or under them unto the said William
