Everett his heirs and assigns forever all the estate right title interest property claim and demand whatsoever in Law or equity of there and each of them the said Aubin Middleton and Thomas Norson of us and to the said tract of Land containing by estimation few hundred acres with the appurtenances thereto belonging to have and to hold the aforesaid tract of Land with its appurtenances to the said William P. Everett his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of him the said William P. Everett his heirs and assigns forever so that the said Middleton and Norson nor either of them nor either of their heirs nor any other person whatsoever claiming under them or either of them shall by any ways or means hereafter have claim or demand any estate right title or interest of us or to the said premises or any part thereof but from all and every action for the recovery thereof and from all and every estate right title interest or demand of us or to the said premises or any part thereof they and every of them shall be utterly excluded and barred forever by these presents in witness whereof the parties of the first and second part to these presents have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day and year herein first written signed sealed and delivered in the presence of us
