Whereas I Kinchen Levy of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia having in my own possession a woman of colour by the name of Phillis who according to the Laws of the said State is in a state of slavery and having considered in my own mind that personal slavery is inconsistent with the principles of Justice and equity and the Laws of nature and good policy do by these presents manumit Phillis of the age of forty three years and I do hereby forever release any claim or demand to the said manumitted Phillis all my right title and interest in her property and forever release I shall hereunto set my hand and seal this 20th day of July 1822 signed sealed and delivered in presence of John Kinchen Levy
