This Indenture made this Eleventh day of March 1822 between James H. Edwards of Southampton County Virginia of the first part and Edwin Edwards of Nash County North Carolina of the second part and William Edwards of Southampton Virginia of the third part Witnesseth that whereas the said James H. Edwards stands justly indebted to the said Edwin Edwards in the just and full sum of three hundred and thirty four dollars and fifty one cents as well appears by his note bearing equal date with these presents but more especially for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said William Edwards before the enrolling and delivery of these presents has bargained granted and sold and by these presents doth bargain grant and sell to the said William Edwards and his heirs and assigns forever four negroes to wit Phoebe Esther Patience and Harry upon the following trust that is to say of the said James H. Edwards shall first to pay and discharge the above mentioned debt with all cost incident to this trust it shall be lawful as soon as required in writing under the hand of the said Edwin Edwards or his legal representatives for him the said William Edwards to sell at publick Auction to the highest bidder for ready money (after giving two days notice by advertisement of the time and place of sale the aforesaid negroes or so many of them as shall be sufficient to satisfy the debt and cost aforesaid and the surplus if any to be paid over to the said James H. Edwards his heirs or assigns in witness whereof the parties have herunto set their hands and seals the day and year above written. James H. Edwards (Seal)
