This Indenture made this 7th day of February one thousand eight hundred and twenty two between Nathaniel Rochelle and Francis his wife of the one part and Edmund L Day of the other part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Witnesseth that the said Nathaniel Rochelle and Francis his wife hath for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand dollars to them in hand paid by the said Edmund L Day with grants bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant and sell unto the said Edmund L Day and to his heirs and assigns forever a certain piece or parcel of Land situate and being in the County of St. Ampton and State of Virginia and adjoining the land of the said Edmund L Day containing two hundred and twelve and a half acres beginning at a small gum the most side of Craffords road thence along a dividing line between Edmonds and Nathaniel Rochelle to a corner tree in the Branch called Pipers thence along that Branch the various courses thereof to a corner of said Edmonds and thence along a line of marked trees between Boley Johnson and Lott Stos to a red oak at Craffords road thence down the road to a dead pine in Pipers corner thence along Pipers line to a new corner made in Lott Sts 1 and 2 standing in a small branch thence south 28 west along the dividing line of Lott Sts 2 to a pine a new corner made in Lott Sts 1, 2, 4 and 5 thence along a dividing line of Lott Sts 1 and 5 south 89 west to a lightwood stump a new line made between Rich Sts Day and Edmund L Day thence along the dividing line of Rich Sts Day and Edmund L Day due East 102 poles to a lightwood post in the old field a new corner line made between Edmund L Day and Rich Sts Day and John A Turner thence S. 15 W. 62 poles to a lightwood post a new line made in Lott Sts 1, 2 and 3 and the dividing line between Nathaniel Rochelle, Edmund L Day and John A Turner thence S. 82 W. 105 poles to a lightwood post a corner of Lott Sts 2 and 3 thence along Edmund L Days old line and Nathaniel Rochelle line of his Lott Sts 2 north 2 west 70 poles to the first station to have and to hold the said parcel of Land unto him the said Edmund L Day and to his heirs and assigns forever against the claims &
