

Negro woman Estith either for cash or upon such Credit as may be by the
 said Francis Williamson directed whether the said sale be for the purpose
 of settling the said debt of them the said Estith and Williamson the said
 Francis being heavily embarrassed for either purpose to direct such sale at what
 time and place within the County of Southampton as to him may seem
 advisable And the said Mr B Brodman for himself his heirs and assigns
 that he will at any time when he shall be as above directed sell the said
 Negro woman Estith and out of the proceeds pay the said debt or
 amount to the said F Williamson according to the circumstances and
 the balance if any then remaining pay to the said William L Estith
 deducting therefrom the expences of said sale and also the expences this
 conveyance also any cost which the said Mr B Brodman may
 incur in and about the premises the said Mr B Brodman not to
 take possession of nor to be in any way answerable for the same until
 by direction of the said F Williamson and the said Francis Williamson
 covenants that he will discharge the said William L Estith from this convey-
 ance so soon as the purpose thereof shall be fully effected In witness whereof

This Indenture made and entered into this 5th day of March 1822 between James
 A Gray and Mr B Brodman Witnesseth that whereas the said James A Gray
 being indebted to the said Mr B Brodman in the sum of two hundred and
 twenty seven dollars and four Cents and being also indebted to several
 other persons in different amounts and wishing to secure to them the
 payment of their several debts or so much thereof as can be effected
 by the sale of all his property of every description and at the same
 time that he wishes to secure all yet without giving any personal
 preference to any having regard to the circumstances under which some of the
 debts were contracted as laying him under additional obligations to
 make any sacrifice for their discharge Now this Indenture
 witnesseth that the said James A Gray in consideration of
 the premises and for and in consideration of one dollar to
 him in hand by the said Mr B Brodman paid hath granted
