This Indenture made the 26th day of February in the year of our Lord 1822 between William L. Everitt and Maria a his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part and Matthew Williams of Jerusalem in the County and State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said William L. Everitt and Maria a his wife on consideration of the sum of one hundred and twenty five dollars to them on hand paid by the said Matthew Williams unto the aforesaid William L. Everitt at the enclosing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said Matthew Williams his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land lying on the County of Southampton and State of Virginia on the south side of Anthony's Creek containing by estimation one hundred and more or less and bounded as follows to wit beginning at a white oak on Edward Hart's line formerly William Hart's line and to the Garden in John Gordon's line a corner over thence along the said line over a pine to a pine (Hart's corner) thence thence along a line of Marked tree
