 recovered certain of his hundred and twenty seven dollars of lawful money of
 Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Arthur Williamson at or before the
 making and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowl-
 edged and he has gained and sold and by these presents hath bargained and sold
 unto the said Arthur Williamson his heirs &c a certain tract or parcel of land
 situate lying and being in the County of Southampton on the south side of the
 three creeks containing one hundred thirteen and a half acres be the same
 more or less and bounded as follows on the East by the land of Arthur
 Williamson on the South by the lands of Susan James Pender of the land
 of James Pender decd and Edward Pender on the West and by the land
 belonging to the estate of James Hannell decd and known by the name of
 the Shackle Lury tract it being the part of the tract of Land sold by
 the said James Hannell of William Lury which Land was sold by
