 for and in consideration of the sum of twenty five dollars current money of the
 United States to them in hand paid by the said Henry Linnom at a place the
 receipt and delivery of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged)
 Have bargained and sold and by these presents do give sell transfer convey
 and sell unto the said Henry Linnom his heirs and assigns ^{and} a certain tract or parcel
 of land containing one hundred and twenty acres being the south most quarter
 of section thirty six of Township three North in Range two East in the
 Territory of Arkansas to have and to hold the said Quarter Section of Land
 unto the said Henry Linnom his heirs and assigns with all and singular the premises and appurtenances
 thereunto in anywise by them or their assigns lawfully to be enjoyed forever.
