This Indenture made this 12th day of April one thousand
 eight hundred and twenty two between Francis Ridley and Lewis
 Ridley his wife of the first part and David Amson of the second part
 all of the County of Southampton and state of Virginia do hereby certify that the
 said Francis Ridley and Lewis his wife hath for and in consideration
 of the sum of one thousand dollars to us in hand paid by the said David
 Amson at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt
 whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold and
 by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said David Amson
 and his heirs forever One half of a certain mill formerly the property
 of William Blunt decd which was decreed by the County Court of
 Southampton to be sold by certain Commissioners therein mentioned of
 which sale the said Ridley became purchaser on which may be seen by
 reference to record the said title lying and being in the aforesaid County
 of Southampton To have and to hold the same title and all advantages
 or privileges appertaining therunto unto the said D. Amson and his heirs
 forever that the above mill is clear do hereby promise and agree to and with
 the said D. Amson and his heirs forever that he alone shall be clear
 free from all other gifts grants sales Judgments Executions and all
 manner of incumbrances whatsoever and by the above mentioned
 contract will warrant and forever defend the first and right
 title thereof to him the said Amson and his heirs forever
