

This Indenture made this eighteenth day of January in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and twenty two between Samuel S. Turner of the County of Southampton Westchester that the said Samuel S. Turner for and in consideration of the love and affection which he hath for Rebecca Jane Williamson hath granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto the said Rebecca Jane Williamson three negroes to wit Pary Young Sam and Mary also the following bonds to wit one bond executed to the said Samuel Turner on the 13th day of December 1821 Demandable till the 25th day of said March for the sum of eight hundred and twenty dollars by Edward Rosen and one other bond executed by John S. Turner to the said Samuel S. Turner on the first day of this month for the sum of one hundred and ten dollars on demand the 25th day of December next To have and to hold the above granted slaves and bones to the said Rebecca S. Williamson her heirs and assigns forever the said Samuel Turner nevertheless reserving to his beloved wife Elizabeth Turner the use and benefit and enjoyment of the above granted slaves during the term of her natural life and the said bones to remain in the possession of the aforesaid Elizabeth Turner until the said Rebecca S. Williamson marries or arrives to Sanfeudage and if the said Samuel S. Turner ^{heirly} do for myself my heirs Executors and administrators forever warrant and defend the right and title in the above granted slaves and other property against the claims and demands of all and every person or persons whatsoever In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the day and year first written
