

This Indenture made and entered into this first day of
 April 1822 between William Littlebury Son of the County of Southampton of the first
 part and Thomas Ridley Sheriff of the County of Southampton of the last
 of his part testifieth that whereas the said Littlebury Son hath
 been taken by virtue of a capias ad satisfaciendum issued of the County
 Court of Southampton in favour of Thomas Gray against the said
 Littlebury Son for the sum of including
 including debt interest cost and Commission by virtue of which
 said writ the said Littlebury Son is taken into custody by
 the Sheriff of said County and being about to take the oath of
 insolvency the said Littlebury Son doth deliver up all his interest in the Land devised by James Son to his
 son Samuel Jones subject to his own life right this Indenture bearing
 further testifieth that the said Littlebury Son for and in consideration
 of the promises aforesaid hath granted bargained and sold and conveyed
 unto the said Thomas Ridley Sheriff of the said County of Southampton
 his Heirs and assigns all his interest in the Land aforesaid to have
 and to hold the said interest in Land with the appurtenances
 thereto belonging to him the said Thomas Ridley Sheriff as aforesaid
 his Heirs and assigns forever and the said Littlebury Son for
 himself his Heirs Executors and administrators doth hereby covenant
 and agree to and with the said Thomas Ridley Sheriff as
 aforesaid his Heirs and assigns that he the said Littlebury Son
 his Heirs and assigns the said interest in said Land with the
 appurtenances unto him the said Thomas Ridley Sheriff as
 aforesaid his Heirs and assigns against him the said Littlebury
 Son his Heirs and assigns forever in witness whereof I have
 hereunto set my hand and seal the day and year above written
