Williams of the other part witnesseth that the said Lewis C. Fitzgerald and Edith his wife in consideration of one thousand two hundred and thirty dollars current money of Virginia have bargained and sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents do bargain alien enfeoff and confirmed unto the said Henry R. Williams one fourth part of the tract of Land lying in the County of Sampson whereof James Harp the father of the said Edith Harp died seized and possessed being the same tract of Land whereon the said James Harp was in his lifetime and which said one fourth is the part to which the said Edith is entitled as one of the devisees of said James Harp and the residue and remaining remainder of said Lewis C. Fitzgerald and Edith his wife to have and to hold the said tract of Land with the tenements hereditaments and all and singular the premises here before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold with say part and parcel thereof and say of their right member and appurtenances unto him the said Henry R. Williams his heirs and assigns forever and the said Lewis C. Fitzgerald and Edith his wife for themselves and their heirs the said tract of Land with the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto him the said Henry R. Williams his heirs or assigns free from the claim or claims of them the said Lewis C. Fitzgerald and Edith his wife or either of them their or either of their heirs and of all and every person whatsoever shall use and as warrant and firmance by their presents or writs whereof they hereunto set their hand and seal the any day year before written
