This Indenture made and entered into this 19th day of March in the year one thousand eight hundred and twenty two between Lewis C Torquart and Edith his wife of the one part and Henry R Williams of the other part witnesseth that the said Lewis C Torquart and Edith his wife in consideration of one thousand two hundred and thirty seven current money of Virginia Law bargained and sold all and in fee simple and confirmed and by these presents do bargain sell and confirm unto the said Henry R Williams one ~~fourth~~ fourth part of the tract of Land lying in the County of Stamilton whereof James Harris the father of the said Edith Harris died seized and possessed being the same tract of Land whereon the said James Harris was in his lifetime and which said one fourth is the part to which the said Edith is entitled as one of the devisees of said James Harris and the residue and remaining remainder of said Lewis C Torquart and parcel thereof to have and to hold the said tract of Land with the tenements hereditaments and all and singular the premises here before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold with every part and parcel thereof and every of their rights member and appurtenances unto him the said Henry R Williams his heirs and assigns forever and the said Lewis C Torquart and Edith his wife for themselves and their heirs the said tract of Land with the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto him the said Henry R Williams his heirs or assigns free from the claim or claims of them the said Lewis C Torquart and Edith his wife or either of them their or either of their heirs and of all and every person whatsoever shall use and as warrant and firmance by their presents in witness whereof they hereunto set their hands and seals the any day year before written
