This Indenture made this 29th day of December 1821 anno domini one thousand eight hundred and twenty one between William Barkham Morm of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Selgman Selks of the same County and State of the other part witnesseth that I the said Barkham Morm for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred and fifty dollars to me in hand paid by the said Selgman Selks the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged I the said Barkham Morm have lawfully granted and sold unto the said Selgman Selks to him and his heirs forever one certain tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being in the County and before written on the north side of the Raccoon Swamp containing fifty ^{and} ~~more or less~~ ^{same} ~~more or less~~ (boundaries as follows beginning at the main run of the Raccoon Swamp at the bridge ^{bridge and road} ~~place~~ up Cross road to a white oak corner of George Bloms line to an Elm in deep branch a corner of said Bloms Land thence down the said deep branch to the run of Raccoon Swamp thence down the run of Raccoon Swamp to the beginning to harvest to hold the said tract or parcel of Land with all its appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appurtenant unto the said Selgman Selks to be held by him his heirs and assigns forever and I the said Barkham Morm for myself and my heirs and all and every person or persons whosoever claiming under them shall and lawfully warrant and forever defend by these presents in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this day and date above written in the presence of Jacob H.
