Then Indenture made the twenty first day of December
 Anno domini one thousand eight hundred and sixteen between Barham
 Morsm of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one
 part and Benjamin Silks of the same County and State of the other
 part testifieth that I the said Barham Morsm for and in exchange
 of the sum of Three dollars to me in hand paid by the said
 Benjamin Silks the receipt whereof is truly acknowledged I the
 said Barham Morsm have bargained granted and sold unto the
 said Benjamin Silks one certain piece of Land situate lying
 and being in the County aforesaid on the south side of the main
 swamp containing the area more or less boundaries as follows
 beginning at the high water mark of nine feet and half on the
 shore of Adams Mill at Tans branch thence along the various
 courses of the edge of the mile Pond to Peter Mannings line thence
 along his line a north course to the run of the Reason Swamp
 thence down the various courses of the run of the said Swamp to
 the mouth of Tans Branch thence up the said branch to the
 beginning To have and to hold the said piece of Land with
 all that appurtenances therunto belonging unto the said Benjⁿ
 Silks to be held by him and his heirs forever And I the said
 Barham Morsm for myself and my heirs and all and every
 Person or Persons whosesoever claiming under them shall and
 lawfully warrant and forever defend by these presents In
 witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal
 the day and date above written
