This Indenture made and entered into this 30th day of April in the Year of our Lord 1822 between Francis P. Williamson of the first part and Clements Rochelle of the other part both of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia do hereby certify that the said Francis Williamson for and in consideration of the sum of six hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the said Clements Rochelle the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained conveyed and sold and by these presents hath granted bargained convey and sold unto the said Clements Rochelle his heirs and assigns one Lot of Land in the Town of Monroe Commonly called the black House which Lot of Land the said Francis Williamson purchased of Abraham P. Ordman trustee for the benefit of James A. Gray. Reference to the deed from Marquette P. Ordman to the said Francis Williamson will fully appear to have and to hold the said Lot of Land with the appurtenances thereto belonging to him the said Clements Rochelle his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of the said Clements Rochelle his heirs and assigns
