This Indenture made this 25th day of May in the Year 1822 between Messers whether
B Brodman of the one part and Francis P. Williamson of the other part
Whereas by a certain deed in Trust executed by Henry Welsh for the benefit
of James A. Gray the said Messers whether B Brodman was authorized and empowered
instructed and directed to sell to the highest bidder at the right which
the said Henry Welsh might lawfully depart withal in certain property therein
mentioned and thereof thereupon to make lawful conveyance to the purchaser
and the said Francis P. Williamson having become the purchaser of a
tract or parcel of Land situated in the County of Southampton about three
miles from the Court House containing one hundred and twenty seven acres and a half
or such interest therein as the said Messers whether B Brodman could lawfully convey
by virtue of the above mentioned Deed in Trust - Now This Indenture witnesseth
that the said Messers whether B Brodman for and in consideration of the premises
and the undertaking of the said Francis P. Williamson to pay to him the said
Messers whether B Brodman the sum of Two hundred and eighty four dollars and
twenty five cents on the first day of January 1822 hath bargained and sold
and by these presents doth bargain and sell to the said Francis P. Williamson
his heirs & a certain tract or parcel of Land situated about three miles from
Jerusalem on the publick road leading from that place to Smithfield
containing by former survey one hundred and twenty seven acres and a half
be the same more or less and lying contiguous to and bounded by the Lands of
Robert Hicks and Burwell Williams of such interest therein as the said Messers
