This Indenture made this 26th day of May in the Year 1822 between Messrs whether  
B Brodman of the one part and Francis P. Williamson of the other part  
Whereas by a certain deed in Trust executed by Henry Welsh for the benefit  
of James A. Gray the said Messrs whether B Brodman was authorized empowered  
instructed and decreed to sell to the highest bidder all the right which  
the said Henry Welsh might lawfully depart withal in certain property therein  
mentioned and thereof thereupon to make lawfull conveyance to the purchaser
