This Indenture made the eighteenth day of February in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty two between Arthur Williamson of the County of Southampton of the one part and Thomas Williams of the said County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Arthur Williamson of the said County of Southampton of the one part for and in consideration of sum of fifteen hundred dollars and 65/100 Current money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Thomas Williams the receipt whereof the said Arthur Williamson took hereby acknowledged hath bargained sold conveyed and confirmed and do by these presents bargain sell alien and confirm unto the said Thomas Williams a certain tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being in the County of Southampton on the South side of the White creek supposed to contain two hundred and twenty and three eighths acres be the same more or less forty acres of the same being reserved by the parties to be subject to the life Estate of Lucy Long bounded as follows to wit north by the road leading from Highford to Jerusalem on the east by the lands of John Washburn and a run line running from through the Adkinson Tract to Allen Long line and on the south by the lands of the said Long and on the west by the land of the said Allen Long and Benjamin Blunt Senior as aforesaid being had to the former and well known fully three and also other lands water water courses profits Commodities Advantages hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the said tract or parcel of Land or in any wise appurtenant and also reversions and reversionary remainders and remainders next & issues of all and singular the premises and every part and parcel thereof and also all the estate right title interest claimed property of or unto the said Thomas Williams his heirs and assigns forever and the said Arthur Williamson the said tract or parcel of Land to the said Thomas Williams his heirs and assigns forever and against him the said Arthur Williamson and his heirs and assigns forever and against all other person and persons whatsoever shall and lawfully can and do forever depared by these presents In Witness whereof the said Arthur Williamson hath hereunto set his hand and seal and affixed his seal and delivered in presence of
