 aforesaid debts on or before the 25 day of Decr. next or when
 thereafter requested by either of the above named parties or by any
 other person by or through them that then and in that case it shall be
 lawful for the said James Rochelle to sell at publick sale in the
 Town of Bournemouth or any other publick place in the aforesaid County
 the aforesaid property after giving at least thirty day publick notice
 of the time and place of sale to the highest bidder and out of the proceeds
 of the said first pay and satisfy the aforesaid debts with all incident
 taxes expenses attending the same and the balance pay over to the said
 William D. Enville or to any person authorized by him to receive it and to
 save William D. Enville doth by these presents warrant and defend
 the right and title in and to the aforesaid property against
 himself and all persons claiming by through or under him
