This Indenture made this 13th day of May in the Year of our Lord 1822 Between Charles W Gordon and Harriette his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part and Robert Gordon of the County of Southampton of the other part Testifyeth that the said Charles W Gordon & Harriette his wife for and in consideration of the sum of two thousand dollars Lawful money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Robt Gordon have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Robert Gordon and his heirs three certain plantation tracts a parcel of Land in the County of Wm aforesaid which was land off and appertains to the said Harriette as her property of the Land of which her Father Henry Barron died seized and possessed by certain Commissioners appointed by a decree of the County Court of Southampton aforesaid and in reference to the report of said Commissioners the situation and boundaries well more fully appear and containing within several tracts as aforesaid two hundred and forty six and 1/2 acres be the same more or less to have and to hold the aforesaid several tract or parcels of Land together with the appurtenances to him the said Robert Gordon & his heirs and the said Charles W Gordon and Harriette his wife their and each of their heirs executors and assigns the said tracts or parcels of Land with the appurtenances to him the said Robt Gordon his heirs and assigns shall and will forever warrant and defend against the Lawful claim of all and every person or persons who Brown In right of whereof the said Charles W Gordon & Harriette his wife have hereunto set their hands and seals the day and Year first before written
