This Indenture made this 25th day of April in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty two Between George S Curley of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and George Curley of the same County and State of the other part Whereas certain John Paine by a certain Indenture bearing date the day of January and admitted to record in the County Court of Southampton on the 18th day of July 1821 did grant bargain and sell unto the said George S Curley his heirs assigns all that tract or parcel of Land lying in the County of Southampton together with the appurtenances to the said Land belonging in and with power and authority to the said George S Curley his heirs assigns and the survivor or survivors of them to sell and dispose of said Land or so much thereof as might be necessary for certain purposes in said deed expressed and ordered the said George S Curley Master in execution of said Trust and after having advertised same as on the 9th day of February 1822 exposed to public sale on a credit of one month in the County aforesaid on the premises one hundred acres of the said Land or more in Trust from Paine to Curley the boundaries of said Land more fully appear at which sale the aforesaid George Curley being the highest bidder for the said Land at the price of four dollars became the purchaser thereof And this Indenture witnesseth that the said George S Curley Trustee in further execution of this Trust aforesaid and for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the said George Curley in pursuance of the said Trust together with lawful interest thereon also the expenses attending the said Trust and
