This Indenture made this 14th day of June 1822 Between William L
Crittall of the first part and Mr B Brodman of the second part Witness
eth that whereas the said William L Crittall is indebted to Arthur
Williamson in the just sum of one hundred and seventy dollars due
by bond and whereas the said Crittall for the purpose of securing the said
debt hath given Francis F Williamson as security for the same &
the said Crittall being willing and desirous of securing and indemni-
fying the said Williamson from any danger in this promise as well as for
the further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said
Mr B. Brodman hath granted, bargained and sold and by these presents
doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Mr B Brodman one certain piece
of Land to have and to hold to him and his heirs forever and the said Mr B Brodman
covenants on this part that he will sell the aforesaid property when ever requested by
the said Francis F Williamson and apply the proceeds to the payment of the
aforesaid debt due Arthur Williamson and in case the debt should not be
paid to the said Arthur Williamson and the said Francis F Williamson in
any manner suffer or be liable to suffer for his security the aforesaid he
will then pay the proceeds over to the said Francis F Williamson and the receipt
of any return to the said William L Crittall and as soon as the same
shall be paid will give the said William L Crittall full acquittance
