of the said John W Mason his heirs and assigns forever and the said

Land in fee simple unto the said John W Mason his heirs &c. both by

John Butts of the same County and parish of the other part Witness that the said
Polly Butts for and in consideration of the good will love and affection that the said
Polly Butts bears for the said John Butts and more especially for the sum of five
dollars good and lawful money of Virginia to her in hand paid by the said John Butts
the receipt whereof the said Polly Butts doth acknowledge herself fully and simply satisfied
and paid hath granted bargained and sold given aliened enfeoffed and conveyed and by
these presents doth give grant bargain and sell unto the said John Butts his heirs and
assigns forever all my right title claim and interest whatsoever in the lands now in the
possession of Selah Champlain which Land I have a right in fee simple of one eighth
part of and of which right in the said Land came to me by my Grandfather
Thomas Williams and as to the bounds of the said Land and the quantity of the
same will appear when ever a legal division takes place which will be after the
