This Indenture made this thirtieth day of April in the Year of our
Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty two Between Mary Amattney
of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and
Edmund Thorppe of the same County and State of the other part
Witnesseth that the said Mary Amattney for and in consideration of
the sum of fifteen hundred dollars current money of the Common-
wealth to her in hand paid by the said Edmund Thorppe the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained and sold
and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Edmund
Thorppe his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of Land
situated lying and being in the above said County of Southampton and
Parish of Saint Luke containing by estimation five acres be the same More
or less and bounded as follows vizt Beginning at a white oak standing
in the Redd Runway near the road that leads from Woods Church
to Morris a corner of said Edmund and Deborah Thorppe's land
and said Mary Amattney thence down the center of the road along
said Mary Amattney's line to a run corner between said Edmund
Thorppe and Mary Amattney in the road in Samuel Morris line
