This Indenture made this 9 day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and twenty two Between Winchen Williams and Rebecca his wife of the
County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Seps Holt of the aforesaid
County and State of the other part Witnesseth that the said Winchen Williams and
Rebecca his wife for and in consideration of the sum of eight hundred and twenty
dollars lawful money of Virginia to them in hand paid and before the sealing
and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Winchen Williams and
Rebecca his wife do hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained and sold
allied and confirmed unto the said Seps Holt his heirs and assigns forever
one certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the aforesaid County
and State containing one hundred and seventy five acres more or less and
adjoining the Lands of John Warham (wherein he now lives to the road leading
from Jerusalem to Bellefield thence into the same Road to John Warham's
land formerly called Murrells land thence along with said Murrells Land to the land
of Allen Jones and thence along said Jones land to the Land of John Throppe formerly
called Murrells land thence along said Throppe Land to the beginning containing
one hundred and seventy four acres more or less and to the said Seps Holt
one hundred and seventy four acres of Land more or less and singular the appurtenances
thereunto belonging to the said Seps Holt his heirs and assigns forever to the said
proprietors and to the said Winchen Williams and Rebecca his wife and to their
heirs and their heirs Covenant and agree unto the said Seps Holt his heirs and
assigns that the said Winchen Williams and Rebecca his wife their heirs
executors admors. shall and lawfully warrant and forever defend the above mentioned
Land and premises unto the said Seps Holt his heirs and assigns forever
ever against the claim or title of all person or persons whatsoever but
Witnesseth that we have hereunto set our hand and seals this
