of the said County of the other part witnesseth that the said Samuel Rivers being party
in debt to Arthur Williamson of said County in the sum of Three hundred and ten dollars
and twenty five cents Virginia money due by him in full payment from him to
the said Arthur Williamson in consideration whereof and promise for an consideration of the
sum of One dollar or there paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
the said Samuel Rivers hath given granted bargained and sold and by these
present doth give grant bargain sell and make over unto the said
Littleton Williamson his heirs and assigns forever the following property
to wit one feather bed and furniture etc setting apart one box
safe three chest one large trunk 1 small trunk 1 Jr. flat iron
Table 1 sofa also my Crop of Corn Tobacco Cotton and all my interest
in the Crop of Benjamin E. Blank as an overus to have and to
hold the said property unto the said Littleton Williamson his
heirs and assigns forever in trust for said Arthur Williamson
his heirs 10th for the reciprocal purpose of paying the said Arthur
Williamson the sum of Three hundred and ten dollars and
