Whitfield of the County of Southampton of the first part Edward Butts of the
same County of the second part and Henry Conley of the third part Moneys
etc. that whereas the said Cady Whitfield is justly indebted to the said
Henry Conley for the sum of eighty three dollars and forty two cents due
by note bearing date the 6th day of July 1822 pay able ten days after

Indenture witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar
or in hand paid by the said Edward Butts to the said Cady Whitfield
into the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Cady Whitfield
that he has granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth hereby
grant bargain and sell unto the said Edward Butts his heirs executors
for ever an certain tract or parcel of Land containing one hundred
and thirty three acres and adjoining the land sold by Jacob Barnes
to Thomas Stornworthy. Nevertheless in special trust and confidence
that the said Edward Butts his heirs and assigns shall at any time after their
day of September next when thereto required by the said Cady Whitfield
or the said Henry Conley after giving ten days notice previous to the day
of Sale and advertise the same at two publick places on the said
County of Southampton sell the aforesaid property to the highest
