This Indenture made and entered into on this 15th day of July in the
year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty five by and between
John Crumpler of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia
of the first part and Evans Pope of the same County and State of
the second part witnesseth that the said John Crumpler for and in con-
sideration of the sum of eight hundred and twenty five dollars to
him the said John Crumpler in hand paid by the said Evans Pope
at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the said
receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold
and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto him the said
Evans Pope his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land
No 2 as by Commissioners report the same being the said John Crumpler
distributionable portion of a certain tract of Land formerly the
property of Edward Drew adjoins the said lot of Land bounded as
follows to wit Beginning at a pine standing in a meadow called
known by the name of Dells a corner of Edmund Everett's and by said
Commissioners made a corner between the said John Crumpler Richard
Sandiford and Martha Drew thence North 23 1/2 degrees west a new
dividing line made by said Commissioners between said John Crumpler
and Martha Drew to a lightwood stump a corner of Jacob Barret's land
thence south 57 degrees east 24 poles variation in said line thence north
58 degrees East 122 p. pole to a red oak a corner of said Barret's land
thence South 45 degrees east 107 poles to a small pine bush a corner
of said John Crumpler and Richard Sandiford made by said
Commissioners in Jacob Barret's line thence South 37 1/2 degrees west
a new line made by said Commissioners between said John Crumpler
and Richard Sandiford to the first station said boundary
contains by late survey one hundred and forty three acres in
