This Indenture made this thirteenth day of January in the
year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty one between William
Oryant of the County of Southampton of Southampton and State of Virginia
and Elizabeth Stephenson of said County and State of Virginia that the said
William Oryant for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and
fifty dollars to him in hand paid at or before the making and delivery of
these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained
sold and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien and confirm
unto her the said Elizabeth Stephenson her heirs and assigns one certain
tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton
and State of Virginia containing by late Survey twenty acres and lands
as follows to wit Beginning at a pine standing on the fish road and in
Sack Darnetts line a new corner of the above named William Oryant
running thence at 48 E 66 S 70 to a pine in the great branch a new
corner of said William Oryant thence down the run of said great
branch to a black gum a new corner of said William Oryant
thence South 40 N 55 West to a small oak in the said Jack Darnetts
line a new corner and on the fish road thence along said line and
up the said road at 55 N 10 West to a pine thence at 111 N 29
West to a red oak thence at 36 N 55 West to a red oak thence
at 69 N 4 West to a Chestnut thence S 77 N 55 West to Jack
Darnetts line again and to the fish road thence up said road at 144
N 13 West to the beginning together with the appurtenances with
the divisions and divisions remainder and remainors unto the
said parties thereof to the county tract and parcel thereof
